





The mild climate, exhaling invigoration upon every gentle breeze, perfumed by the sweet breath of pine woods, palm groves, and orange trees, grants to the dwellers in the land plentiful enjoyment of life and health, throughout the winter, such as in other places is not afforded, in so lavish measure, even in spring.

A. J. C. Hare, in his « *Gloss of South Italy and Sicily* » refer to the place in which Palermo lies, under the ancient well deserved name of *Conca d'Oro* — « *Golden shell* »: « *The situation of Palermo is wonderfully beautiful: the town is surrounded by a vast garden of orange and olive trees which fills the Conca d'Oro* » This golden shell is ever warmed by brilliant sunshine, beaming from a clear dark blue

sky, through the ambient air, and rendering Palermo « *the best*





stations at the same season of the year.

Preferable to the Riviera, being warmer in winter; while snow, fog, cold winds and storms — not rare in the so called *Côte d'Azur* — are, here, actually unknown.

Amusements.

Within the « Villa Igica ».— There are easy and pleasant walks in the immediate vicinity of *Villa Igica*, among long avenues of magnificent oak trees, blooming oranges, or the characteristic prickly pears; yielding views of the *Conca d'Oro* and the Bay.

At the distance of a half an hour walk, or fifteen minutes drive, the Park *La Favorita* is attained; and hence, through lovely country roads, in about three quarters of an hour, is reached the beautiful shore of Mondello.

A band plays every afternoon on the large terrace before the main building; a concert is held, in the central hall, every Thursday night; popular songs, accompanied by mandolin and guitar, are given during dinner, every Sunday evening.

There are lawn-tennis and golf grounds; yachting by sail and steam in the 320 tons yacht *Igiea*.

In the town.— In the same direction as *La Favorita* lies the town itself, where are many beautiful public parks, and the grounds of private villas, generously thrown open to visitors. Among the former are the *Giardino Inglese*, the *Villa*



Giulia and the *Orto Botanico*, beautifully planted, and kept in order; while, among the latter, the *Villa Florio*, the *Villa Tasca*, the *Villa Trabia* and many others are more than remarkable.

In the Morning, interesting visits may be paid to the Museum, the *Cappella Palatina*, the Cathedral, all containing real treasures of art; to many other churches, palaces, and Saracen castles; or spent in the short excursion to *Monreale*, by electric car or carriage — through the road commanding the *Conca d'Oro* — and visiting the celebrated cathedral and cloister, in which are found the finest mosaics in the world.

Monreale is reached by electric tram car, in about twenty minutes, or by carriage in an hour.

In the afternoon, may be enjoyed a drive on the Promenade of the *Via della Libertà*, thronged with elegant carriages; or to the

Marina, a splendid quay on the sea.

In the evening, there are: the Opera, at the splendid Teatro Massimo; the *Opera Comique*, at the Politeama; the Italian Drama,

at the Teatro Bellini; Ballet, Operette, Café-Chantant, in different places, as the *Olympia*, the *Alhambra*, etc. etc.

Excursions in Sicily. — Excursion in the island and its surroundings can be undertaken, in comfortable 1st and 2nd class carriages, by rail, to places where remains of the former Greek and Phoenician inhabitants can be inspected, as Solunto, Girgenti, Segesta, Selinunte, Taormina, Syracuse, etc. — By yacht, to the Eolian islands, and the coasts of Sicily. — The yacht *Igiea* is a fine 320 ton vessel, built expressly for the *Villa*.

From London Paris and Berlin to Palermo: Express international train to Naples; from Naples to Palermo, ten hours by steamer. Beautiful steamers, lately built, with every comfort, luxurious fittings, clean, well served and rapid; bearing satisfactory comparison — in proportion with their size — with the best English liners.

By rail from Naples: Thirteen hours to Messina, crossing the Straits in ferry boat; four hours from Messina to Palermo.



custom house for-

mality and for readily finding carriages, boats and guides; as *Igæa Office* will take care of everything. On account of special agreements with the General Italian Navigation, steamers departure is in coincidence with the arrival at Naples of international expresses. The easy and delicious journey from Rome to Palermo is so reduced to sixteen hours only. For persons who, in spite of all the comfort, luxury and rapidity of steamers, prefer to avoid crossing the



sea, *Villa Igica* Office offers the same help for the journey by rail, providing for good sleeping-car places, whilst the luggage is forwarded by sea, arriving at *Villa Igica* even before the travellers to whom it belongs.

Besides the Post and Telegraph Offices, the Bank service and Information Office within *Villa Igica*, travellers will find a special Office for delivering railway and steamer tickets, registering luggage, and performing every other formality.

This travelling-Office connected with the sicilian Grand Hotel takes special care, for trips in Sicily. Besides every information required for excursions to Sicilian monuments, *Villa Igica's* guests will find at Girengi, Siracusa, Taormina, experienced local guides belonging to the hotel — who will previously provide for any arrangement needed, from meals to convenient accomodation, if a longer stay is required by travellers. — Besides these arrangements, for persons who care to visit Sicily's inland, the great attraction for *Villa Igica's* guests are the archeological excursions made in commun, arranged by the Direction. Parties are formed, now and then, guided by professors in archeology, who will make the trip not only useful and interesting, but merry and jolly by out-of-door lunches amidst classic

ruins, popular songs sung by natives in the picturesque costumes of the different countries.

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

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
